General Guidelines:

- ✓ Online registration is available prior to the show at <https://tinyurl.com/2022ShowEntryForm>. Contact the Grayson County Extension office for registration information at 276.773.2491 or spurlink@vt.edu.
- ✓ Breed registration documents must be provided for purebred classes upon request.
- ✓ All youth exhibitors, adult chaperones, parents and spectators will be respectful to, and celebrate all youth exhibitors. Any individual(s) displaying inappropriate conduct will be asked to leave the premises.
- ✓ No wash facilities available on site. Animals must be washed prior to the show.
- ✓ Each exhibitor is expected to properly care for his or her animals while on exhibit.
- ✓ Animals found to be unhealthy or harboring some stage of disease will be asked to leave the grounds immediately.
- ✓ No intact males shall be allowed to show except for poultry.
- ✓ No animals with horns greater than 6 inches long will be allowed to show.
- ✓ Youth showmanship classes are based on age of exhibitor as of January 1 of current year.

Goat Show

Rules for the Goat Show:

1. Exhibitor must be able to control and handle goat while exhibiting the goat in the show ring.
2. Only does and wether goats are eligible to show.
3. Goats must be clean and presentable.
4. Goat committee reserves the right to determine classes according to entry numbers.
5. Goat committee reserves the right to cancel, add, or combine classes as they see fit.

The classes for the goat show will be as follows:

- Senior Showmanship (Age 14-19 as of January 1st of current year)
- Junior Showmanship (Age 9-13 as of January 1st of current year)
- Novice Showmanship (Age 5-8 as of January 1st of current year)

Meat Goats:

- Junior kids 6 months & younger
- Senior kids 7-12 months
- Yearling kids – 12-24 months
- Champion market kid
- Does – 2 years & older
- Does 3 years +
- Grand & Reserve Champion Doe

Dairy Goats:

- Junior Kids 6 months & younger
- Senior Kids 7-12 months
- Dry Yearling (never freshened) under 24 months of age
- Grand & Reserve Champion Junior Doe
- Young Milkers - under 2 years
- 2 Year Old Milkers – 24-35 months
- 3 Year Old Milkers – 36-47 months
- Aged Milkers – 4 years and older
- Champion & Reserve Champion Milker
- Supreme Champion Dairy Goat

- Novice Showmanship (Age 9-11 as of January 1st of current year that has never shown at the Grayson Livestock Show before)

Sheep Show

Rules for the Commercial Ewes & Showmanship:

1. Animals in showmanship classes can be a commercial ewe or market lamb
2. All animals must be shown clean and dry.
3. No shearing on-site
4. Lambs exhibited in commercial ewe class may not be shown as market lamb and vice versa.
5. Only ewe and wether lambs are eligible to show.
6. All wool lambs must be docked.
7. Market lambs will be shown by weight.
- 8. Exhibitors can show a maximum of 3 single lambs and 2 commercial ewes.**
9. All lambs must be shown with a maximum of ¼ fleece.
10. Management reserves the right to determine the number of classes.

The classes for the sheep show will be as follows:

- Senior Showmanship (Age 15-19 as January 1st of current year)
- Intermediate Showmanship (Age 12-14 as of January 1st of current year)
- Junior Showmanship (Age 9-11 as of January 1st of current year)
- Novice Showmanship (5-8 years old that has never shown Grayson Livestock Show before)
- Pee Wee Showmanship (5-8 as of January 1st of current year)
- Special showmanship classes (announcements made day of show)

Commercial Ewe Show

- Junior Ewe Lamb – Meat Breeds (Lambs born 3/1/22 – 4/30/22)
- Senior Ewe Lamb – Meat Breeds (Lambs born 1/1/22 – 2/28/22)
- Yearling Ewe – Meat Breeds (12-24 months)
- Aged Ewe – Meat Breeds (> 2 years)
- Ewe Lamb – Fine Wool Breeds (< 12 months)
- Yearling Ewe – Fine Wool - Breeds (12-24 months)
- Aged Ewe - Fine Wool Breeds (> 2 years)
- Junior Hair Sheep (<12 months)
- Yearling Hair Sheep (12-24 months)

- Aged Hair Sheep
- Champion Commercial Ewe
